<b>BACKGROUND</b>	The main objective of the project was to involve high school students in the world of volunteering by stimulating civic and social engagement in young people in Trentino. In addition to a training course on enviromental issues, the right to study and the right to food, the project introduced the use of a web/mobile platform ( <a href="http://www.cittadinicrescono.org">www.cittadinicrescono.org</a> ), developed by FBK, in which voluntary associations were able to share with students volunteer opportunities.

<b>METHODOLOGY OF MONITORING</b>	The degree of achievement of the set objectives was evaluated positively on the basis of the questionnaires filled by the students.

The participatory methodology has been effective</b> as evidenced by the skills acquired and verified through questionnaires.</li> <li><b>2. Students joined the volunteering activities proposed</b> for total of 124 hours of volunteering.</li> <li><b>3. The platform <a href="http://www.cittadinicrescono.org">www.cittadinicrescono.org</a></b>, created during the project, is now an element of contact between the world of volunteering and young people.</li> </ol>
